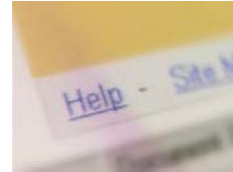

Online course schedule information



Priority registration

Priority registration is a time designated by Suffolk University to allow students the opportunity to register for courses without making an initial deposit. Once the period is over, the Student Accounts/Bursar's Office will mail out tuition bills to students.

The Online Program has reserved 2 weeks prior to the University priority registration exclusively for online students to register for online courses.

What does this mean to you?

It means that you can register for an online course without the worry or concern of a course filling up. It is highly recommended that you use the exclusive priority period for online students and register for course(s).

After the first two weeks, online courses will open to the rest of the campus community with the exception of SB 600, MBA 780 and MBA 800. You may continue to register for online course, however, please note that online courses are popular among campus students and they may fill up quickly.

Priority Registration Period for Spring and Summer 2016

October 26– November 8	Only fully online students can register for spring and summer 2016
Suffolk University priority registration:	
November 9, 2015	Spring 2016 online courses open to campus students (with the exception of SBS 600 [formerly MBA 600], MBA 780, MBA 800).

Registration Exceptions (online students):

The following courses are available online **ONLY** to fully Online MBA students.

3. MBA 800W*

New Student Orientation (NSO):

If this is the first MBA Online course you are taking, you must register for **MBA 001 -NSO First-Time Online Users** with the Registrar's Office. This is a 0-credit, 0-fee introductory course. **Newly admitted, please contact Ana Perez at aperez@suffolk.edu with the session you want to register for, please include your full name and ID#. The NSO is hosted prior to the start of the semester and the system will not allow you to register for the session on your own.**

The NSO is offered 2 times the week prior to the semester start date. Below are the dates for Spring and Summer 2016. Please note that you only attend the session that best fits your schedule.

NEW COURSE: FIN 880 W1

Description:

Students analyze the main functions of investment banks such as origination, syndication, and distribution of security issues. They examine pricing of new issues and secondary offerings by investment banks, mergers and acquisitions, leveraged buyouts, valuation of closely held companies, and restructuring of distressed companies. The role of investment bankers in restructuring industry and financing governments and ethical issues faced by investment bankers will be studied.
