SPSS, Inc. is the name of a company that produces a computer program SPSS, used for statistical analysis. Between 2009 and 2010 the premier software for SPSS was called PASW (Predictive Analytics SoftWare) Statistics. The company announced July 28, 2009 that it was being acquired by IBM. As of January 2010, it became "SPSS: An IBM Company"

IBM SPSS software is installed on all computers in classrooms and is available to SBS and CAS faculty on request.
