

Connecting to Suffolk University's wireless WPA2 networks on iPad

This Quickstart Guide will help you to connect to WPA2, Suffolk University's secured wireless Network for faculty, staff and students. Students will need their Suffolk username and password to access **SU_Student_WPA2**. Faculty and staff must use their Suffolk desktop username and password to access **SU_Staff_WPA2**.

Step 1



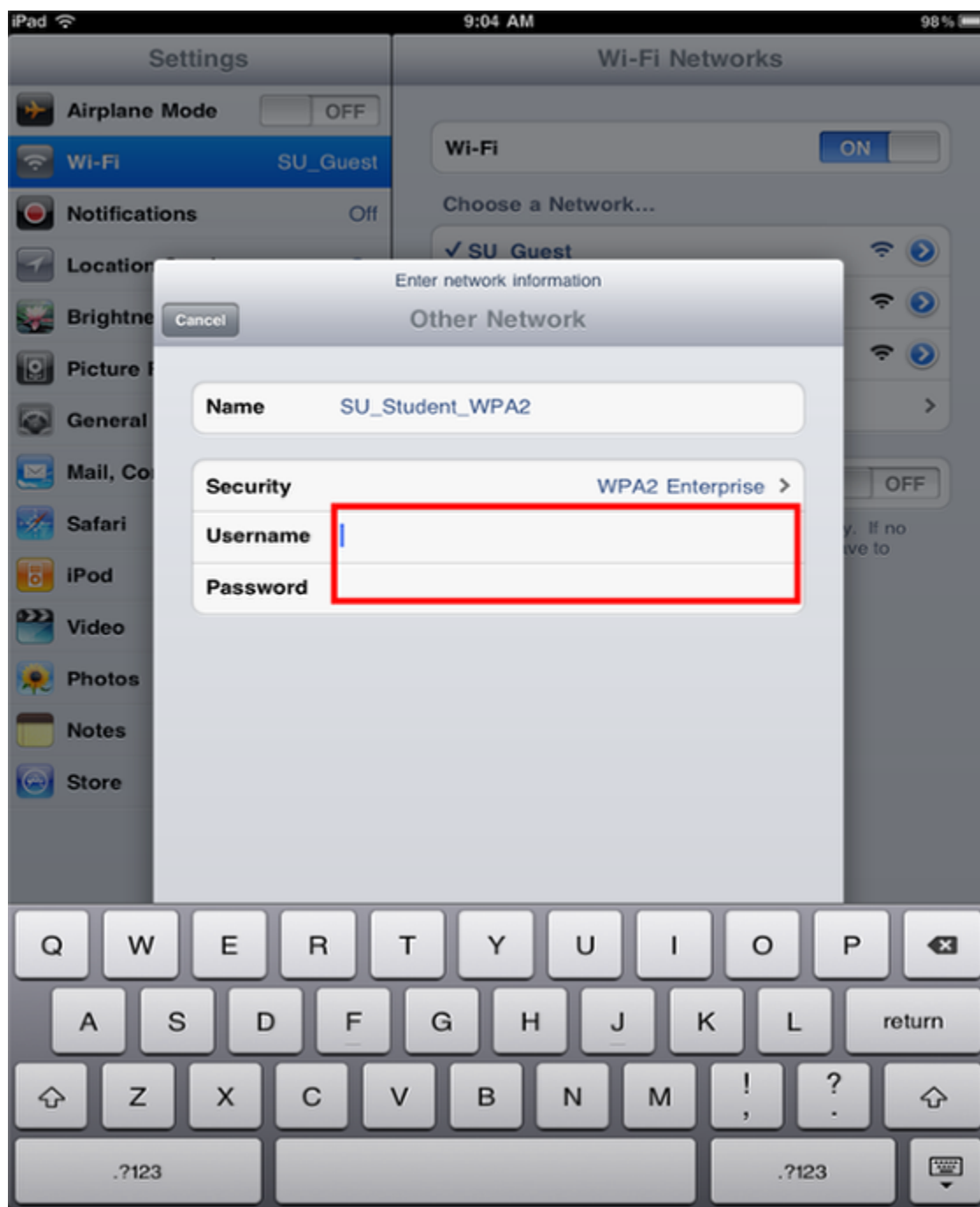
Go to the *Settings* app

Step 2



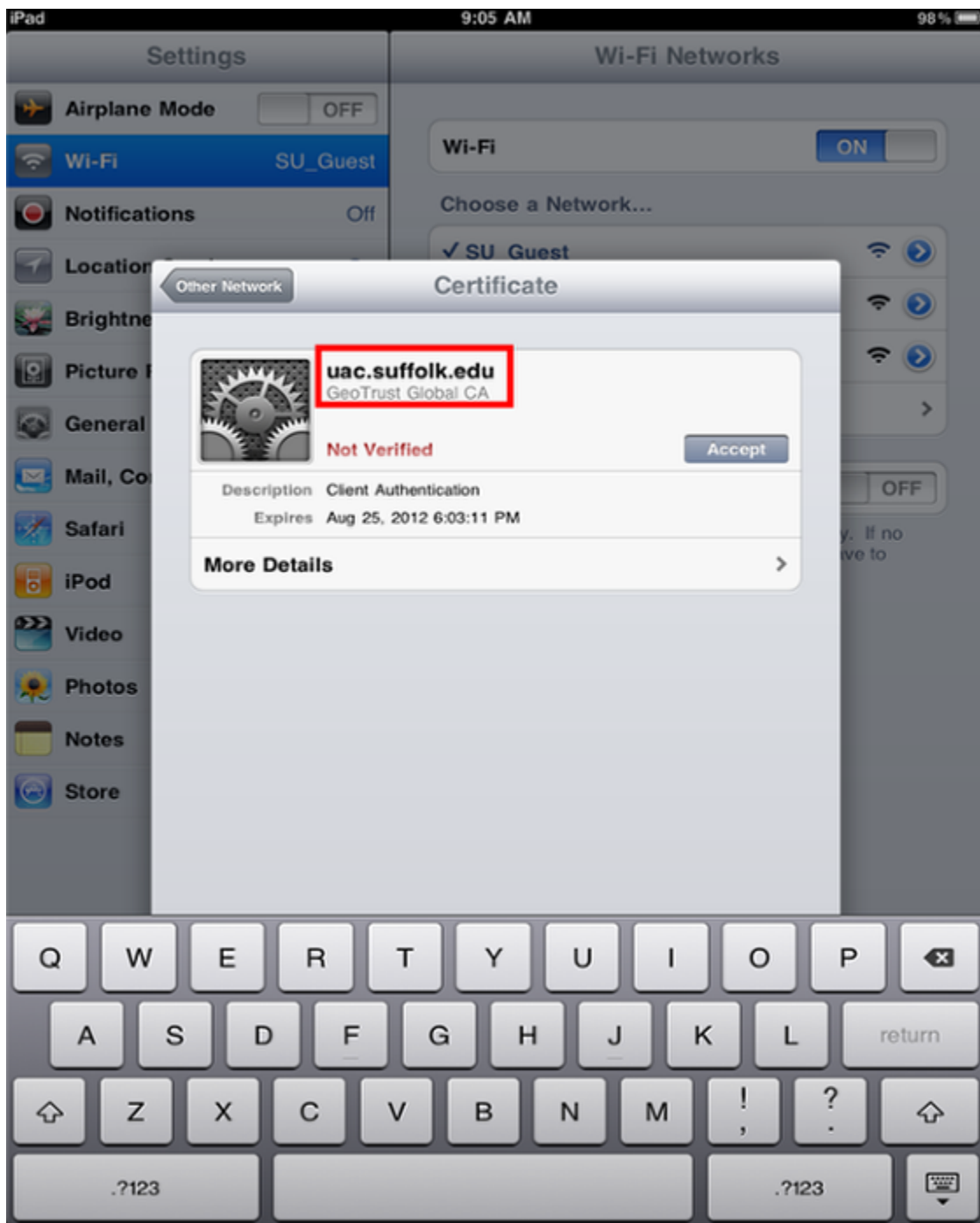
1. Select *Wi-Fi*
2. Select **SU_Student_WPA2** or **SU_Staff_WPA2**

Step 3



Enter your Suffolk University email username (without the @suffolk.edu) and password. Faculty and staff must use their Suffolk desktop username and password

Step 4



On the certificate page, verify it says “uac.suffolk.edu” and hit Accept. You should now be configured for Suffolk University wireless with WPA2 on the iPad!

Finished!

You should now be connected to the **SU_Student_WPA2** or **SU_Staff_WPA2** wireless network.
