


Step 1

Select Wireless & networks


Step 4

Now scroll down until you see Add Wi-Fi network.




Select Add Wi-Fi network.



In the $\bf Network~SSID$ input the either $\bf SU_Student_WPA2$ or $\bf SU_Staff_WPA2.$




Click the down arrow on **Security** it will bring you into the following screen below.




Choose the WPA/WPA2 PSK option.



Input your email Password and hit Save.




You will be returned to the Wi-Fi settings screen. Hold down on SU_Student_WPA2 and select Modify network.




Select the MSCHAPV2 option.
