
## Connecting to Suffolk University's wireless WPA2 networks on Android




Step 1



Go to Settings and select Wireless & networks



Check the box to the right of Wi-Fi and tap Wi-Fi settings



Under Wi-Fi networks, select either SU\_Student\_WPA2 or SU\_Staff\_WPA2
