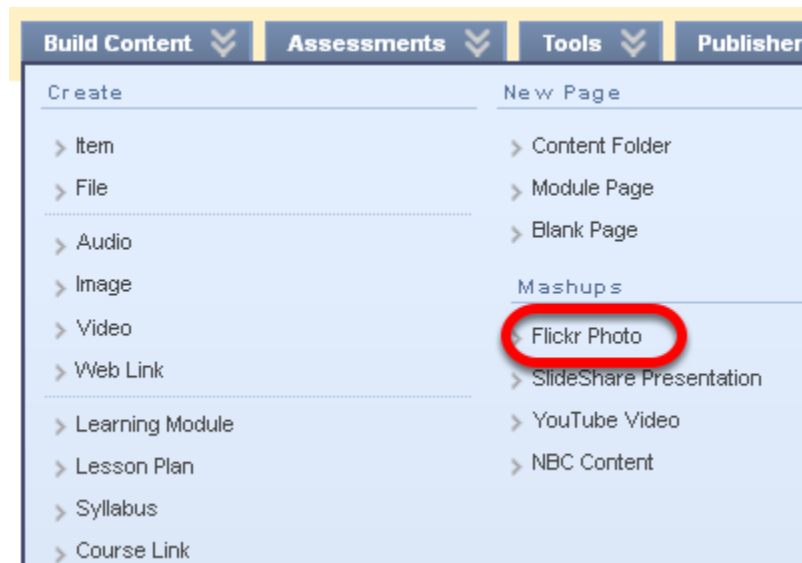


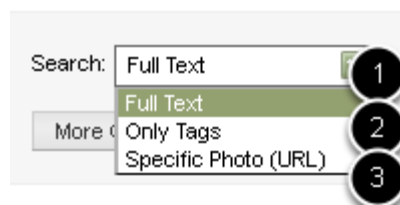
Adding an Image from Flickr

This lesson covers how to find and add images from the popular free image hosting and sharing site, Flickr. Flickr is a "Mashup", and one type of content that is possible to add to a course.

1. From the Build Content Menu, choose Flickr Photo



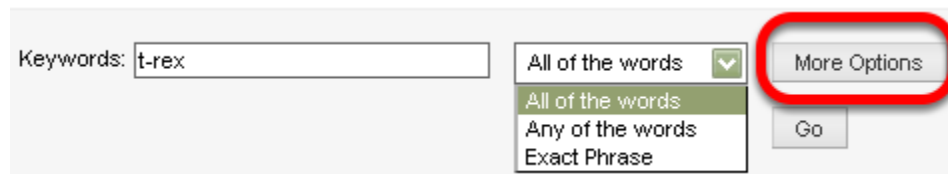
2. Decide the Kind of Search you wish to Conduct



You can search for

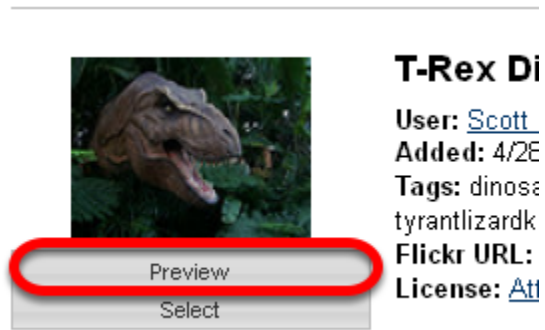
1. full text associated with the image
2. only tags that authors have entered (or not)
3. a specific image

3. Enter your Search Terms and Further Define your Search



NOTE: *More Options* allows you to search using additional criteria such as the date

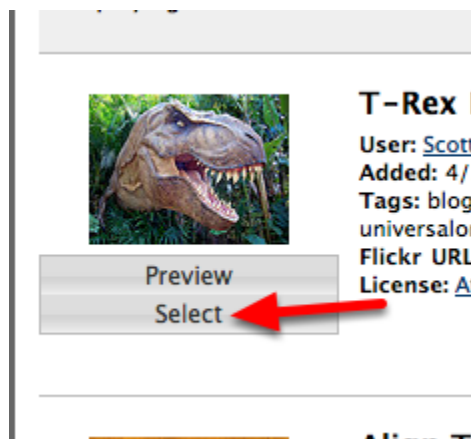
4. Scroll to an image you might choose, and select Preview to see it more clearly



5. To exit Preview Mode, click the X on the upper right corner of the image



6. To select any image to put in your course, choose Select from under the image thumbnail



7. Give the image a name of your choosing
